

## Australian Forest Growers Tasmanian Fellowship 2008/2008

Australian Forest Growers is a national association representing private forestry and commercial tree growing interests in Australia. Established in 1969, the association has Branches in all states. It is run by a voluntary Board of growers with support from a small professional staff based in Canberra.

The fellowship is offered by the Tasmanian Branch to members of Australian Forest Growers and their families.

The fellowship has been created through generous sponsorship by the Tasmanian forest sector to the Biennial Australian Forest Growers National Conference, Launceston 2006. Information about conferences and Australian Forest Growers can be found at [www.afg.asn.au](http://www.afg.asn.au)

This fellowship will assist persons further their education. For example, the fellowship could be used to assist with tertiary studies, other studies or supervised projects, research projects, accredited training courses, workshops and conference attendance.

The educational activity must improve the applicants skills and knowledge and also be shown to provide benefits to the private forest sector.

The fellowship has a value of up to \$5,000 and must be spent with 12 months of receipt of the fellowship. The fellowship can be used to top-up other funds available to the applicant.

Applications will be considered by judging panel of members of the Tasmanian AFG Branch. They rank applications and make recommendation to the Branch Committee. All applicants will be notified within six weeks of the application closing date.

## Australian Forest Growers Tasmanian Fellowship 2008/2008

The successful applicant will be required to make a presentation about the educational activity at either the AFG Annual Farm Forestry Dinner in Launceston, an AFG field day or write a brief article for the AFG national journal, Australian Forest Grower.

Applicants are to provide the following information, not exceeding two A4 pages:

- Name, Postal Address, Phone Number, and Email address.
- A Description of 'educational activity' i.e. Name/title of activity, Institution/Training Body/Organiser:
- Location, Duration and Total cost of activity.
- Amount of fellowship sought, Fellowship expenditure: (how funds will be spent), Benefit to Applicant and Benefits to the private forest sector.
