The 2022 Annual General Meeting saw the branch welcome a new member Bonnie Galbraith, who has fulfilled the role of Secretary. Further, the meeting saw Molly Marshall continue her role as Chair and Nick Martyn as deputy Chair. We would like to acknowledge Stephen Walker who has withdrawn from the committee, his strong contribution to multiple Forestry Australia committees in his time shows his dedication to the sector.

Over the past twelve months the Tasmanian branch has worked hard at implementing the strategic objectives which were set last year. This has seen three key events hosted across the South, North and North West of the state. The branch has continued to focus on collaborations with key organisations/individuals who are interconnected with the forestry sector.

A successful jointly hosted breakfast 'Looking Back, Moving Forward' was delivered in collaboration with the TFFPN with over sixty people in attendance to hear from Bryan Hayes, Peter Volker, and Tony Price. Building upon the momentum of that event, a field day was organised in the following two months. The 'Lower Styx Field Day' allowed members to visit and understand the forest evenness trails being conducted in the South of the state.
