



N.W. JOLLY MEDAL NOMINATION FORM

PURPOSE

The Award is named in honour of Norman William Jolly (1882-1954) who made an outstanding contribution to development of professional forestry in Australia in the first half of the 20th Century.

The N.W. Jolly Medal is Forestry Australia's highest and most prestigious honour for outstanding service to forestry in Australia. It recognises contributions from across the full scope of forestry and reflects the diversity of significant contributions being made across a wide range of disciplines and forest management activities.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Any person, whether or not a member of the Forestry Australia may be nominated if they have made an outstanding contribution to forestry and the contribution supports achievement of Forestry Australia's [objectives](#).
2. In this context forestry includes sustainable management, development, and use of all forests for the manifold goods and services that forest ecosystems provide whether for public, private or commercial purposes, including - education, research and development, forest policy and all types of forest land management.
3. A person deceased since the closing date of nominations for the previous award shall be eligible.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Any financial Voting Member of Forestry Australia can nominate a person for the N.W. Jolly Medal. The nomination should be seconded by another financial Voting Member.
 - Nominations can be made by completing the nomination form below.
 - Up to five pages of additional information detailing the nominee's work and publications may also be submitted.
- The nominator may seek information from the person being nominated however once a nomination is made, we ask that the nominators not discuss the nomination.
- All confirmed nominations will be considered by the Merit Awards Committee,
