ABOUT THE FOREST VALUATION SUMMIT

Forestry Australia's 2026 Forest Valuation Summit will be held in person at Rendezvous Hotel, Melbourne, on Monday 30 and Tuesday 31 March 2026.

The Forest Valuation Summit is a two-day gathering, bringing together forest sector leaders, valuers, investors, and stakeholders to explore the future of forest valuation in Australia.

The Summit will feature the launch of the first Joint Australia New Zealand Forest Valuation Standard, an initiative of the New Zealand Institute of Forestry and Forestry Australia, with the support of Forest and Wood Products Australia (FWPA).

The release of the Joint Forest Valuation Standard coincides with the introduction by the Australian government of new sustainability and climate reporting standards. The introduction of these new standards collectively represents a significant development for valuations of Australian forest assets and entities reporting forest values in Australia, which will be unpacked at the Summit.

The broad program will also include critical themes such as market dynamics and carbon valuation – and will feature a social function, to facilitate networking and collaboration in an informal and relaxed environment.

BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

GST

All monetary amounts are in Australian dollars and are exclusive of Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Confirmation & Payment

Sponsorships will be allocated in the order that a signed booking form has been received. Once a signed booking form and payment has been received the sponsorship will be confirmed via email. Payment can be made via credit card or by requesting a tax invoice.

Cancellation by Sponsor

All cancellations must be received in writing. By signing the booking form, the organisation agrees that Forestry Australia will retain 10% of the contract price in the case of a sponsorship cancellation that is received on or before 90 days prior to the Summit. Cancellations received between 90 - 30 days will incur a 50% cancellation fee. No refunds will be provided for cancellations received within 30 days of the Summit.

Privacy

Forestry Australia will not supply member email, telephone or postal details to sponsors. A PDF Delegate List will be provided that includes name, organisation, suburb and state.

Use of funds & compliance

Forestry Australia agrees to use all of the funds provided to support the organisation in its mission.

Public & Liability Insurance

Public and Liability insurance to a minimum of AUD\$10 million must be carried by each sponsor. A copy of the certificate of insurance currency may be requested by Forestry Australia's National Office.

Liability & Indemnity

Forestry Australia shall not be liable in any manner for any loss or damage whatsoever to any files, artwork or other materials of the booker which may be deposited with Forestry Australia for the purpose of fulfilling the entitlements, and such materials shall, at all times, and in respect of all things, remain at the risk of the sponsor.
